

Freedom Pass circuit

Section X1-3: West Drayton to Slough

Distance: 6.43 mi, 10.29 km

Introduction

This section is a very straightforward. Nearly all of it is along the towpath of the Slough Branch of the Grand Union Canal, in almost a straight line.

There are place to eat in West Drayton and Slough, as well as a pub in Langley.

Directions

Leave West Drayton Station on the north side, by platform 5, and turn left.

Turn right at the mini-roundabout.

Go over the canal, and turn right three times in quick succession. You are now on the towpath.

At the next bridge, leave the towpath and turn left across the bridge.

Go straight on at the mini-roundabout.

Cross Fray's River, and follow the road round to the right.

Bear left past a yellow barrier.

Between a left and a right bend, bear right onto a footpath, which initially runs alongside the road.

Just before the path crosses the Slough Branch, take the footpath on the left down to the canal.

Carry on along the towpath for several miles, all the way to the end. If you turn left at bridge no. 8, you will reach a pub in 5 minutes.

At the end, turn left along the main road.

Take the first right, Montague Road.

At the end, turn left.

Take the second left, Queen's Road.

Turn right into Grays Road.

At the crossroads, turn left.

Turn right at the traffic lights.

Turn left into Railway Terrace.

Slough Station is on the right.
